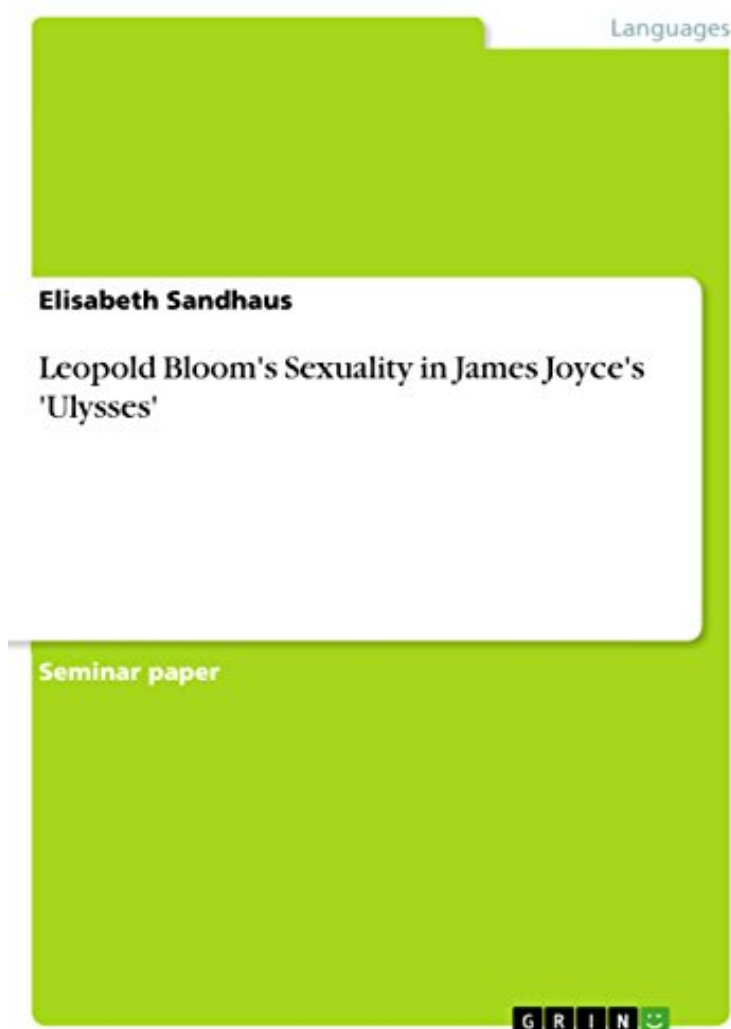


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# Leopold Bloom's Sexuality in James Joyce's 'Ulysses'
